Catholic Cemeteries Association is expanding our monthly Grief Support program to include groups at Calvary Cemetery in Cleveland and Calvary Cemetery in Lorain and are seeking group leaders. Qualified candidates will have National Catholic Ministry of Consolation certification through the Diocese of Cleveland, a calling to serve the bereaved in our communities, and a compassionate and listening heart. Candidates will have the ability to work with diverse groups of people with varying grief needs and be beyond any significant personal grief/loss. Grief support groups meet the 3rd Sunday of every month from 3-4 pm. (Group leaders arrive a half-hour early to set-up.) The grief support leaders will facilitate and guide discussions, not counsel. Support group leaders will receive a small stipend for each session led. If you are interested but cannot commit to a monthly group, we are also seeking individuals to serve as substitute group leaders at our five support group locations.

PASTOR'S NOTE

As a young Catholic growing up, as a seminarian and as a deacon and priest, I've been a part of some wonderful parishes in our diocese! St. Adalbert in Berea is where I grew up. Holy Family, Parma, St. Raphael, Bay Village, St. Malachi, Cleveland, St. Mary, Mentor, Gesu, University Heights and Holy Spirit, Avon Lake were where I had serious involvement as a seminarian. I ministered as a deacon at St. John Neumann in Strongsville and as a priest at both St. Gabriel, Concord Township and St. Mary in Painesville. Summer at every parish I've ever been a part of has been an opportunity of renovation and adjustment. At our two parishes this summer we are talking about some social activities like the Urban Renaissance Festival at St. Mary and the Parish Picnic At St. Bernard. Maybe a few other things as the year goes on. We will have free books issued about how to live an engaged and holy life in a suffering church beginning in July. We are implementing a revised set of handouts for people who come for funerals weddings, all the sacraments and a revised workplace handbook. I'm meeting with each staff person individually to make sure we are on the same page, connected and satisfied with how we work together and what we do in our weekly work. At St. Mary the roof and interior are undergoing reassessment with the help of diocesan facilities employees, the parking lot stripes will be repainted and new signs will go up on the perimeter, especially in the parking lot. At St. Bernard we implemented the T-coil hearing loop audibility enhancement for the hearing impaired, handicap accessible, power assisted exterior doors and are working on a new ceiling and lighting system in the Parish Hall. God's plan of constant renewal is alive in your summer recreation, too! Make time for it to happen! Renewal starts in our hearts first! -Father Chris
