Since April of 2002 the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland has published on its website the names of those clerics who were removed from ministry from 2002 through the present as a result of the sexual abuse of a child. At Bishop Perez's direction, this information has now been compiled in a list format and updated to include the names of additional diocesan clerics who were removed from ministry as a result of sexual abuse of a child or who is already deceased or no longer in ministry for any reason and against whom have been made substantiated allegations of child sexual abuse. The new names of diocesan clerics were added after the diocese concluded, based on the evidence available to it, that the allegations were more likely than not to be true. In compiling this updated information, the diocese reviewed all known allegations regardless of how long ago the alleged abuse occurred or whether the cleric was alive or deceased.

While the updating of this information is certainly an occasion of profound sadness, inasmuch as it reminds us of the great harm experienced as a result of sexual abuse, may it also be an occasion for healing and a step towards restoring trust in the Church.

PASTOR'S NOTE

Hello! I am Ana Maria Baker, the new Parish Catechetical Leader (PCL) at St. Bernard! Father Chris asked me to introduce myself to you this week. I came to the USA from Peru in 2004, met Bob and we got married in 2005. Noah, my son was born a year after, and now he is a teenager! My father, Tuto, an awesome support, lives with us. We usually attend the 12:00 mass. I am looking forward to being a PCL for my own son and for all the children and families of this church. What does that mean? First, it means making sure our catechists and programs comply with diocesan and national standards for child safety: background checks for every catechist; a program for catechists and families about child safety during the course of catechesis sessions; and complying with annual audits on these items. Second, it means leading catechesis! What is Catechesis? At one recent diocesan Catechist workshop, we learned that *catechesis* comes from two Greek words: "kata," which means coming down and "ekhos," or echo. This year I noticed Fr. Chris needed help "handing down the echo" of the Good News to the children and families preparing for First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. Myself and some others offered to help and since then we have been working to train catechists to teach baptism classes to parents and godparents every third Saturday at 5:30 pm, we've revised the registration process for Baptism classes and Baptisms and we are about to revise the lesson plans for First Reconciliation and First

Holy Communion. All this in both English AND Spanish. I will be working with the children programs primarily, but maybe I'll see you at an adult session on Thursday evening or at church!
