

REV. DAVID C. MARSHALL, C.S.Sp.

Rev. David C. Marshall, C.S.Sp., a member of the Congregation of the Holy Spirit died August 21, 2003.

Father Marshall was born April 15, 1920 in Norwich CT. On August 15, 1944 he made his vows in Ferndale, CT and was ordained to the priesthood there June 4, 1946.

Following his ordination, he was an assistant at St. James Parish, Alexandria, LA for five years and later principal of Girard High School in Phoenix, AR. He also served at St. Joseph's House for Boys in Philadelphia and the Holy Ghost Prep School in Bensalem, PA. (1963-1964). He directed the Holy Ghost Retreat House, New Canaan, CT (1968-1975) and served as Assistant Academic Vice-President at Duquesne University (1977-1981). Fr. Marshall was then assigned to parochial ministry serving as Pastor at Sacred Heart, Emsworth (1984-1989) and at St. Theresa Parish, Tiverton RI (1989-1995). In December of 1995 he retired to Congregation's retirement home in Sarasota, FL and in 2001 to Libermann Hall, Bethel Park.

Son of the late John B. Marshall and Catherine Burke, Father is survived by his brother Mark Marshall of Houston, TX, Donald of Tucson, AR, a sister, Paula Bauer of North Haven, CT. and many nieces and nephews.

Burial will take place in the family plot at St. Joseph's Cemetery, Norwich, CT.
