



## NURSE'S NOTE

Dear Parents,

If your child has been exposed to chicken pox and has already had the disease or has been immunized against it, there is a very slight chance that he/she may get the disease.

Chicken pox is characterized by spots resembling blisters, A fever, headache and sore throat may precede the outbreak. The incubation period is 12-21 days. Children with chicken pox must be excluded from school until all the blisters have scabbed over.

Please notify the health office if your child becomes infected by chicken pox.
