The Dedication Of The Lateran Basilica

November 9, 2014



Dear parishioners,

Today we celebrate the Dedication of St. John Lateran. St. John Lateran is the cathedral church of the Diocese of Rome and the official ecclesiastical seat of the Bishop of Rome, who is the Pope.

It is the oldest and ranks first among the four Papal Basilicas or major basilicas of Rome (having the cathedra of the Bishop of Rome), and the oldest church in the West. The other three major basilicas of Rome are St. Peter, St. Mary Major, and St. Paul outside the Walls.

Inside above the altar are two mitre-like reliquaries. One contains the head of St. Peter; the other, the head of St. Paul. Along the entire apse of the church are enormous statues of each of the twelve apostles.

Two interesting things about this basilica are that this is the church where the Holy Father celebrates the Holy Thursday liturgy—until this year when Pope Francis washed the feet of twelve prisoners in a prison. Across the street from the front of the basilica is a large statue of St. Francis of Assisi and his followers. This represents St. Francis and his brothers coming to St. John Lateran in 1210 to ask Pope Innocence III to approve his rule.

## St. Mary's Parish History

### *DID YOU KNOW?*

The land that was purchased with Paris Owens' money by his parents is the land that was St. Mary's until we purchased the adjoining lots in 2000. The original land was purchased for \$80 from Charles and Jane Godfrey for Rt. Rev. Amadeus Rappe, bishop of Cleveland, on March 8, 1864. That is equivalent to about \$1160 today. Paris' older brother Andrew Jackson Owens used to come each Sunday to light the fire to warm the church, to pick the readings and the songs. Andrew and his wife Anna had a home on Main Street where Tu Pueblo is today. He could walk straight down the alley to get to St. Mary's.
