## Lenten opportunities

Every Wednesday during Lent we will have Stations of the Cross at 6:30 and Mass at 7:00. Every Thursday from 8:00-9:00 there will be opportunity for Adoration.

This Lent there will be no Penance service. There will be instead additional opportunities for private confession: before each Mass on Saturdays and Sundays, on Wednesdays, March 2 and March 16 from 5:00 to 6:30 (7:00) and after Mass until all who wish have received the sacrament.

As you know, there are two days of fasting (only one full meal) for those between 18 and 59—Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. These two days and all the Fridays of Lent are also days of abstinence (no meat) for those ages 14 and onward.

Don't forget that the season calls us to prayer, fasting, and almsgiving. We are called to change our hearts.
