## GOOD NEWS! Maybe...

You may have heard that a Federal Magistrate has stayed the next three Ohio executions; however that is only pending a decision in a peripheral case about access to information regarding execution protocols and drugs. OTSE believes it is prudent to expect the execution on January 12 to go forward as scheduled until a more firm reprieve is in place.

The up-side to this is that Governor Kasich is unlikely to announce his decision regarding clemency for Ronald Phillips until it is clear that his is the final word. This means your calls, emails, letters and postcards to Governor Kasich are more vital than ever! There are still postcards on the table in the main entrance.

There's still work to be done for the unborn. The governor signed a bill outlawing abortion after 20-weeks but vetoed bill banning abortion when there is a fetal heartbeat.
