Thanks to the generosity of two donations of over \$5,000; Mrs. Crain and Mrs. Back had one of their "Classroom Big Wishes" granted. Mrs. Crain received a large roll of magnetic whiteboard to replace portions of her chalkboard and Mrs. Back will receive all new classroom desks and chairs! If you or someone you know is interested in seeing the remaining items on the list, it is available in the school office. More good news was received this week, as St. Michael School was awarded a matching school safety grant from the Indiana Department of Homeland Security. The grant totaled \$26,288.47 with St. Michael needing to match \$6,572.12. The grant was written for a closed circuit interior and exterior security camera system, totaling 35 cameras with motion sensors and zoom capability. This is a much needed school safety upgrade to ensure our students are safe in and around St. Michael school. God Bless and Stay Safe!

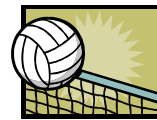
