I have enjoyed this Faith Formation year with your children at all grade levels, the retreats, and the sacraments. One of the greatest gifts that we can give to our children is our knowledge of God's love. I thank you for the sacrifices you make for your children to be a part of this program, and I encourage you to keep the commitment to worshipping God on Sundays with us. Being a part of Sunday Mass is what makes us Catholic, and that is what we want for you and your family.

With constant evaluation of the ministry, I am always striving to offer the best program for your children. During the spring and summer, I will be updating our syllabi, books, and logistics of each grade level. If there is any major change that would affect the schedule, I will update you asap. For now, our schedule for next year remains:

- Grades 1&2: Classes will be every Tuesday from September thru March with two retreats in November and February.
- Grades 3, 4, 5: Classes will be once/month on Wednesdays 3:30-5:30pm at the church hall, with grade level Sunday retreats in January. Busses are provided from MHHS down to the church hall
- Grades 6, 7, 8: 6th grade classes held on alternating Thursdays with 7th and 8th on alternating Mondays.

The Twelve-a program for 7th and 8th graders: With a successful first year, we are offering the two-week summer program including catechetical lessons, service projects, spiritual development, and fun activities! Program dates are M-F July 15th-26th 9am-12pm.

Registration Information

To register before May 15th and take advantage of the discount, payment in full is not needed, it can be deferred.

Registration forms need to be handed in with a deposit and a payment plan established.

- Enclosed is the pre-printed 2019/20 registration form for your child(ren).
- Enclosed is the bill with the breakdown of registration charges.
- Register before May 15th to take advantage of the discount.
- At time of registration, payment must be either:
 - 1) Paid in full or
 - 2) Set up with a payment plan by either credit card or post-dated checks.
- If you mail in your registration, please send full payment or fill out payment plan option on the back of bill. (*provide credit card # or post dated checks*)
- If there is an error on your bill, please call the office and we will look into the matter for you.
- Incomplete forms cannot be processed and will be put on hold.
