GOD'S FACE?*

In celebrating the Feasts of All Saints and All Souls, each of us is given an opportunity to reflect on the questions: *who am I* and *where am I headed?* Let me consider them one by one.

WHO AM I? I'm a native of Boston, the descendant of Irish immigrants. I'm the oldest in a family of seven boys. I'm an American citizen. I live in Moore, Oklahoma. I'm a Catholic priest and pastor. While all of those statements are descriptors of who I am, they omit what is most important. *I'm a sinner who has been saved by the grace of God. I'm an adopted child of God, called to make known to all the Good News of Jesus Christ.* Today, I choose once again to be his disciple and pray for the grace to be a faithful follower. *I am called to be a Saint.* Achieving that is impossible for me, but completely possible for God.

WHERE AM I HEADED? As a sinner called to become a Saint I am destined to live forever with God and all his chosen ones. I really have no idea where heaven is located geographically other than to say that I believe it is wherever God's will is done. Jesus tells me that to enter his kingdom I have to walk along the *narrow road*. I imagine that road to be something like the road to the village of Emmaus in Luke's gospel. Two disciples were hurrying away from Jerusalem lest they be crucified like Jesus. They had hoped he would be the one to set Israel free from bondage, but now they didn't know what to believe. Then Jesus showed up and opened the meaning of the scriptures to them to the point that their hearts were burning. Because they were open to his Word, they were able to recognize them at supper *in the breaking of the bread*. So, I too am on a road—however narrow—knowing that Jesus is walking along with me, revealing himself and his will to me as we go. I like to think that I am among those who long to see him one day *face to face*.

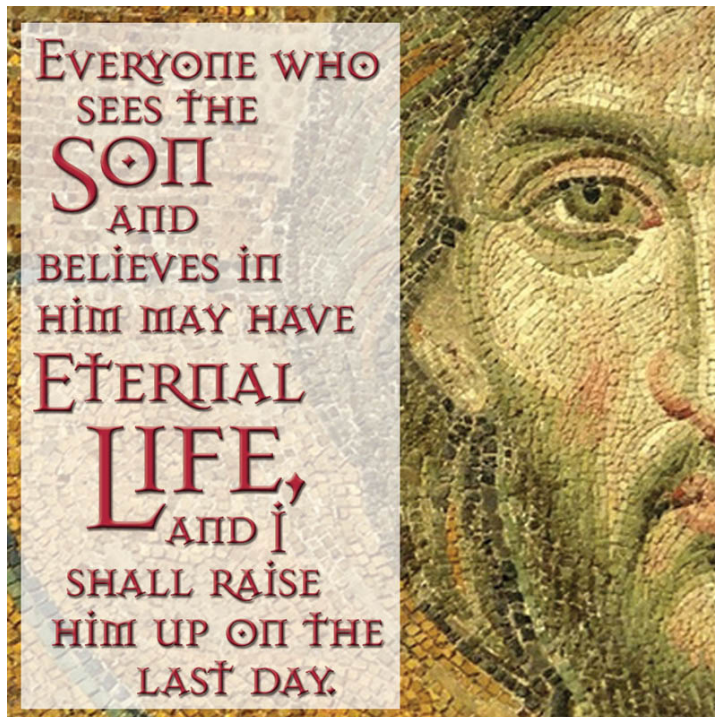

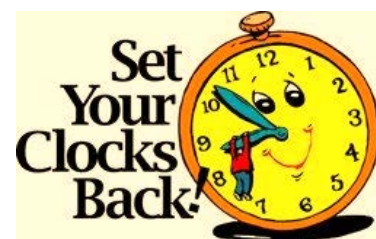
