



Dear Students and Parents,

Students in grades 4 through 12 are invited to consider serving God and the community at Our Lady of Peace as altar servers. Altar servers play an important role in the way others worship God at Mass, much like Lectors, Communion Ministers, or musicians. In addition to being a wonderful service ministry, serving also helps youth enter into the Mass in a new way by learning about the actions, vessels, prayers and other elements. This type of servant leadership can develop into lifelong faith practices.

SCHEDULING AND COMMITMENT: Each server will be scheduled at the Mass times that your family is able to attend about two times a month. It will be your responsibility to see that he or she is there at the scheduled time and to offer encouragement and support, especially by your attendance at Sunday worship.

If your son or daughter would like to be an altar server and you are able to offer the necessary support, please send this form back with your child for the training session. After training, I will send you an email explaining how the scheduler system works. Our system is a user-friendly way to submit any weekends that a server is unable to serve at Mass and to request a sub if something comes up.
