ACTIVITY CHOICES - All activities will be presented at age appropriate levels. All classes are subject to change.

EVERYDAY:

SNACK - A healthy snack and drink will be provided. Parents are responsible for providing any food allergy information on registration forms. Snacks may be brought in by the student but no high sugar items or candy will be allowed.

HOMEWORK - The scheduled homework time is a "quiet zone" time where students will have a tutor available. Students and parents will sign a contract agreeing to the terms of the "quiet zone". If and when homework is completed, students are permitted to study, read silently or practice handwriting (drawing for PreK).

STRUCTURED PLAY - Students will participate in active physical activity that will be guided / supervised by teachers. Play will take place outside on the playground - weather permitting.

MONDAY:

HISTORY - Students will learn about important moments in History through an interactive lesson and activities that will include "Twilight Zone" reenactments. Fun facts that they might not know.

MATH - Math is fun! Students will use a variety of age appropriate games and hands-on activities to help students improve their understanding and skills of this subject. Students will see how math skills are used in everyday living.

TUESDAY:

ARTS & CRAFTS - Students will learn many techniques to turn ideas into their own creative reality. Self expression is the goal - not perfect pleasing art! (PreK-2nd)

DIGITAL STUDIES - Students will learn about online safety, art, coding, photography & video. (3rd-8th)

DANCE - Students will get their energy out before going home for the night. Simple dance moves to appropriate music will be taught or if free-style is the desire, we will dance on!

WEDNESDAY:

ENGINEERING - Students will be looking at how things are made & try to recreate them using different materials.

TEAMWORK - Students will be given a task where they will have to make something move or work.

THURSDAY:

ETIQUETTE - Students will learn how to set a table, how to speak mindfully to others & how to sit for certain situations.

STRETCH STRONG - A fun, challenging and relaxing way to help students improve strength and flexibility - it's not as easy as it looks and requires a lot of strength and focus!

FRIDAY:

SCIENCE - Science can be crazy fun! Students will not only do fun hands-on experiments but will also learn the steps of the Scientific Process. Students are sure to become more curious and develop a desire to understand how things work.
