

Parish of the Precious Blood – Building & Grounds Minutes

June 6th, 2017 Meeting at Holy Rosary Parish center.

The meeting of the Buildings & Grounds council for June 6th Meeting was called to order at 6:40pm by Council Chair Rodney Bourgoïn.

The minutes from our last meeting of April 18th, were reviewed by council. Ronnie Fournier motioned they be approved. Jim Lavaway 2nd the motion. Minutes approved and accepted as written.

Old Business Reviewed:1)

1) St. Denis-The council was presented with the estimates from Lane Construction \$19,875 and Quality Paving \$4,800 for the repair of St. Denis parking lot. Discussion was had concerning the disparity in estimates it was explained that Lane was proposing to repair a larger area than required. Council voted to approve the estimate from Quality Paving.

2) Our Lady of the Lakes-Discussed the gutter work estimate from DESO Seamless Gutters of \$1,650. Council approved the scope of work.

3) St Mark's-Council discussed the exterior staining of St. Mark's it was decided to precede with getting estimates.

4) St Louis- Discussion on repairing foundation and entrance steps it was decided to precede with the repair work.

5) St. Joseph's- The roofing should be completed by 6/9.

Review of current and needed projects:

1. Albert House asbestos remediation will begin the week of 6/11
2. Pressure washing of St. Mary's will begin week of 6/11
3. Rod Bourgoin and David will meet at St. Catherine's to address roof issues.
4. Peter LaJoie presented the council with 2 proposals from Buck Construction and NicCait for the canopy over the front entrance at St. Mary's. Project cost is being donated by the Presque Isle Knights of Columbus. Peter also presented the council with paving estimate of grass area between garage and church the estimate of \$9450 was from Trombley Industries. Peter will solicit more bids.

Open Discussion:

Discussed projects for the Youth Mission kids. It was explained by David that the intent of the mission is to go out into the community but if there was not enough community projects we can add Parish projects as fillers.

Next meeting was scheduled for August 15th, in Caribou at the parish center for 6:30 PM.
