Please note that parents and godparents are required to complete a baptism preparation course, which is offered at the parish church on third Sunday of each month. For Baptism, at least **one** sponsor (godparent) must be a baptised, confirmed and practicing Roman Catholic. **Godparents must submit a copy of their Baptism Certificate at Baptism Preparation Course.** Before your child can be baptized, the parish office **must** have a copy of your child's **birth certificate.** **To register contact the parish office @ 279 1625.** Baptisms take place the **second Saturday & last Sunday of each month.**

Collection for Needs of the Church in Canada

Every year, the Bishops of Canada make an appeal for financial assistance to support their work and the work of each diocese by means of the Collection for the Needs of the Church in Canada. The President of the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCCB), the Most Reverend Paul-André Durocher, Archbishop of Gatineau, has described this Collection as "an opportunity for all the faithful in our country to give a hand to helping the Gospel!" The annual Collection allows each diocese to meet its financial obligations to the regional episcopal assemblies and to the national episcopal Conference. "Any additional revenues raised help the diocese support its own diocesan pastoral programs and other activities," Archbishop Durocher explains. The CCCC is the national assembly of the Catholic Bishops in Canada, and includes the Bishops of the Eastern Catholic Churches.

The Collection for the Needs of the Church in Canada will be held September 27 and 28, 2014.

Through your contribution to the Collection, you too can collaborate with the Bishops in their ministry to teach, sanctify and govern.
