AN INVITATION FROM ARCHBISHOP CURRIE... PILGRIMAGE ON "THE TRAIL OF THE CARIBOU"

As your Bishop I wish to remind you that the years 2014-2018 mark the 100th anniversary of the **First World War**. We must never forget! Knowing that many of those brave volunteers were members of our Church, I am sponsoring a spiritual pilgrimage to the battlefields of Europe in the summer of 2016. I have asked Craig Travel, a well-known travel company, to work out the details. Over the next few months you will begin to see advertisements for their special tour tentatively called, "On the Trail of the Caribou, 2016." I personally invite you to consider this tour as we visit both the battlefields where our people fought in World War One and the cemeteries in which they are buried. In June-July 2016, there will be a group from this Archdiocese travelling to France and Belgium, and converging with many other groups at Beaumont Hamel on July 1. On that day, with Bishop Geoff Peddle of the Anglican Church I will lay a wreath in the remembrance ceremony at Beaumont Hamel. The tentative and approximate cost is \$5000.00 (all-inclusive). I will provide more information as it becomes available.
