Please note that parents and godparents are required to complete a baptism preparation course, which is offered at the parish church on third Sunday of each month. For Baptism, at least one sponsor (godparent) must be a baptised, confirmed and practicing Roman Catholic. **Godparents must submit a copy of their Baptism Certificate at Baptism Preparation Course.** Before your child can be baptized, the parish office **must** have a copy of your child's **birth certificate.** **To register contact the parish office @ 279 1625.** Baptisms take place the **second Saturday & last Sunday of each month.**
