

**Baptism Preparation:** A Fee is applicable for a Baptism and **must be paid at the Parish Office before the Baptism takes place.** Parents and godparents are required to complete a baptism preparation course, which is offered on the third Sunday of each month at 1:00 pm in the Parish Church. For Baptism, at least **one** sponsor (godparent) must be a baptized, confirmed and practicing Roman Catholic. **Godparents must submit a copy of their Baptism Certificate at the Baptism Preparation Course.** Before your child can be baptized, the parish office **must** have a copy of your child's birth certificate. To register, contact the parish office at 279-1625.

**MARRIAGE PREPARATION PROGRAM – ST. JOHN'S:** The final dates for the 2019 Marriage Preparation Program are as follows: May 31<sup>st</sup> & June 1<sup>st</sup>. Registration Fee is \$100 per couple and all sessions will take place at Mary Queen of the World Parish Hall, Topsail Road, St. John's. The Friday evening session begins at 6:30 p.m. and ends at 9:00 p.m. The Saturday session begins at 9:30 a.m. and concludes at 3:30 p.m. To register for the program couples will have to contact Theresa Whiffen at the Archdiocese at (709) 726-3660, extension 236 and indicate that you are calling to register for the Marriage Preparation Program and the weekend you have chosen. *There will not be a Marriage Preparation Program held on the Burin Peninsula this year and couples should register early.*

**FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER  
MAY 19<sup>TH</sup>, 2019**

*Saint Arcangelo Tadini  
(Feast: May 20<sup>th</sup>)*

Arcangelo came from a well-off family in Verolanuova, Brescia, Italy. Though anti-clericalism was rife among his peers, Arcangelo knew from an early age that he was called to the priesthood. He was ordained in 1870.

After a first assignment in the mountain village of Ludovino, where he founded a soup kitchen to feed families displaced by floods, Arcangelo was transferred to Botticino Sera, where he was to spend the rest of his life. He became passionate about the fate of the factory workers. Seeing the desperation of those who had lost their incomes due to disability or age led him to establish the Workers’ Mutual Aid Association for fraternal support. When the daughters of the families began to leave to find work in far-off cities-there to become prey to the unscrupulous-he gave them work close to home. Using his own inheritance, Arcangelo built and outfitted a spinning mill. He constructed a residence for the girls. To provide companionship and training, he founded the Congregation of Worker Sisters of the Holy House of Nazareth in 1900. The sisters taught by example, working alongside the girls at the looms.

Lame from an accident at age eighteen, Arcangelo was nonetheless often seen in prayer standing before the tabernacle. He carried his rosary always. The smiling priest spent his final years in a wheelchair. He was canonized in 2009.

**Victoria Day:** The birthday (May 24, 1819) of Queen Victoria (+1901) has been celebrated as a holiday in Canada West (now Ontario) since 1845; it became a National Holiday in 1901 and in 1952 was established on the Monday preceding May 25.
