Reflection by Javier

Once again Jesus is challenged by the Pharisees who are scandalized by Jesus' popularity among "tax collectors and sinners." As always, Jesus finds his way to challenge them. He weaves together a collection of parables that reveal the very heart of God is full of love, mercy, and compassion for all, especially those who are consider "the lost." Pope Francis, in his book *The Name of God is Mercy*, says that Jesus moves according to a different kind of logic and shows us a new horizon that points to God's Love. Jesus heals and integrates the marginalized, the ones who are outside the city, the ones outside the encampment. By doing so, he shows us the way. What a challenge we received from today's readings! Let's remember that we are still celebrating the Year of Mercy. We are invited to imagine that we are the object of God's mercy and compassion; we are the recipients of the overflowing love of the Father, just like in the parable of the prodigal son. What are you willing to do in this week to show the same love and compassion that you have been shown? Don't forget that "love, after all, can never be just an abstraction. By its very nature, it indicates something concrete: intensions, attitudes, and behaviors that are shown in daily living" (*Pope Francis*).


