GOSPEL MEDITATION- Jesus is in the Father and the Father is in Jesus. All that Jesus, the Word of God, does is an expression of the Father. Jesus does nothing on his own. Today's Gospel says, "Whoever believes in me [Jesus] will do the works that I do, and will do greater..." The works of Jesus included welcoming, consoling, healing, loving, forgiving, breaking down racial and gender barriers and manifesting God's presence in action and word. How are we doing the work of Christian discipleship? In what ways are we manifesting the presence of God?

CATHOLIC SOCIAL TEACHING CORNER

On this Sunday, our Risen Lord is recognized as the Good Shepherd who

protects us and cares for us. Being the recipients of God's care, we need to realize that Peter's words to the people of Jerusalem are addressed to us as well – we too must reform and embrace a new way of living if we wish to be a part of Christ's fold. That new way of life is to bring God's care - and mercy to the poor, the vulnerable, the forgotten and abandoned through our relationships with them.

Family Connection Even though we have less experience with sheep and shepherds today in our society, we can still identify strongly with the image of Jesus as the Good Shepherd and as the gate for the sheep. Psalm 23 remains a popular and favorite psalm for prayer. In the image of the Good Shepherd, we know ourselves to be protected and cared for by a loving God. As your family gathers, ask what each person knows about sheep and shepherds. Recall that shepherds and sheep have a close relationship. Sheep will only follow their own shepherd; they recognize his voice and will not follow a stranger. The shepherd's job is to protect his sheep. In some ways, the relationship between the shepherd and his sheep is like that of a parent and child. Read together this Sunday's Gospel, John 10:1-10. Talk about how Jesus tells us that He is the gate for the sheep. The sheep enter the protection of the sheepfold through the gate. In Jesus we find protection and abundant life. Conclude by thanking Jesus for being our Good Shepherd and by praying today's psalm, Psalm 23.
