Ingredients:

- 1 tablespoon chili powder
- 1 teaspoon cumin
- 1 teaspoon paprika
- 1/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper
- 1/4 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon salt
- 1 teaspoon ground black pepper
- 3 tablespoons olive oil, divided
- 1 1/2 pounds boneless, skinless chicken breast, sliced into strips
- 2 bell peppers, sliced
- 1 onion, thinly sliced

Instructions:

- Whisk together chili powder, cumin, paprika, cayenne pepper, garlic, salt and pepper in a small bowl.
- Heat 1 tablespoon olive oil in a cast-iron frying pan over medium-high heat.

- Add chicken and sprinkle with 3/4 of fajita seasoning. Mix together and sauté until cooked through, about 4 minutes.
- In a second pan, heat remaining 2 tablespoons oil over medium heat.
- When the oil is hot, add peppers and onion. Stir in remaining fajita seasoning. Cook until vegetables are soft, about 5 to 7 minutes, stirring occasionally.
