The stew resulted in a total of \$11,930.00 being added to the endowment fund. Leading the donations was a check from the Yoakum Knights of Columbus #1582 for \$5,000.00. This was the 28<sup>th</sup> year for the stew supper. The total contributed to the endowment fund over these years is now over \$167,943.00. This money will never be spent but will continue to earn money to be used to defray operating expenses of St. Joseph School. This year the earnings from the endowment fund resulted in a check of \$30,000.00 being given to the school for such expenses.

Thanks to the generosity of many, there were no expenses associated with putting the stew on as all the work, facilities and stew were donated.
