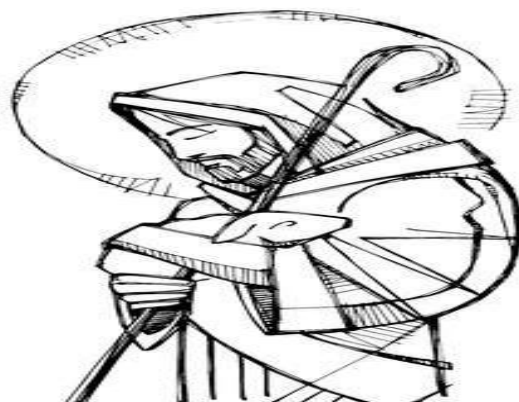
## Gratitude
