July 4th: Independence Day Note

We will still have Devotions to the Sacred Heart at 6:10 am on First Friday with Exposition, Adoration and Benediction (July 5th).

Diocesan Rosary Congress

The Holy Rosary remains a tried and true devotion and treasure of our Catholic faith. The Blessed Mother directs us to her Son and desires our union with Him through meditation and reflection on the Paschal Mystery. Bishop Cahill has invited the entire diocese to join together in October for a diocesan-wife Rosary Congress. It will begin with the Sunday evening vigil of the feast of our Lady of the Rosary (October 7th—also known as the feast of Our Lady of Victory—the patroness of our diocese). It will include special periods of Eucharistic Adoration and recitation of the Rosary. More information will be available and posted in the months ahead. Pray the Rosary and “do whatever He tells you,” as Mary pointed to Jesus at Cana.

Solemnity of the Sacred Heart

Friday, June 28th is the Feast of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. We will have exposition, Devotions to the Sacred Heart and Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament at 6:10 am preceding the Votive Mass of the Solemnity.

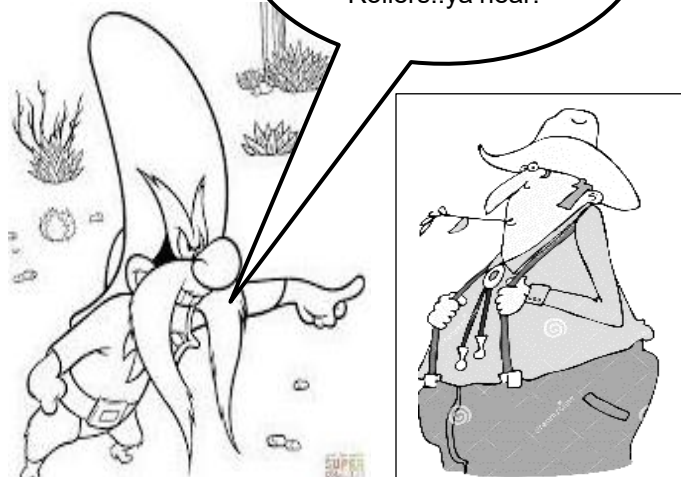

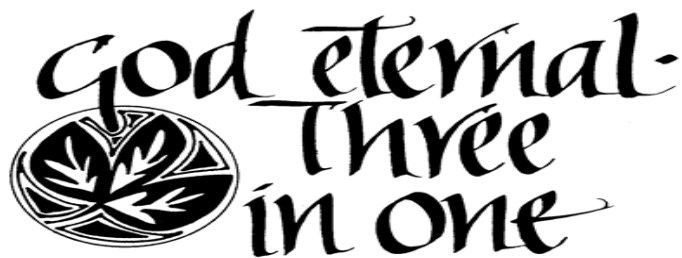
