## CCD Registration

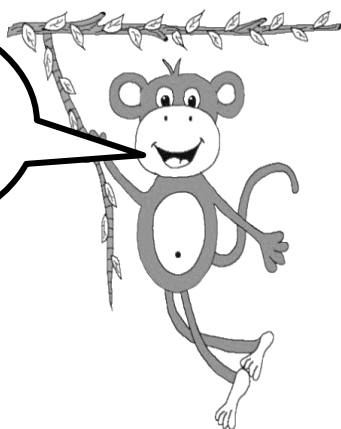

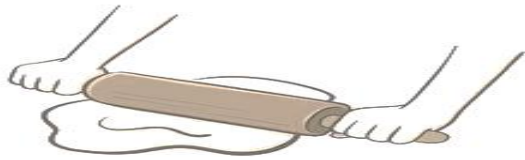


### Attn: Texas A&M & Blinn College Incoming Freshmen
