Diocesan Rosary Congress

Bishop Cahill has invited the entire diocese to join together in October for a diocesan-wide Rosary Congress. It will begin with the Sunday evening vigil of the feast of our Lady of the Rosary (October 7th - also known as the feast of Our Lady of Victory - the patroness of our diocese). It will include special periods of Eucharistic Adoration and recitation of the Rosary. More information will be available and posted in the months ahead.
