This class is mandatory for individuals who are interested in assisting or participating in any school function, field trip, CCD aide. Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion, etc. Anyone interested in becoming Safe Environment compliant **must complete the online application (www.victoriadiocese.org) prior to attending the class.**



Divorce and Remarriage

Anyone who has experienced the pain and challenge of divorce after marrying through the Church as we are taught as Catholics are to do, may be open in the future to the possibility of a solid and lasting relationship in their life...in which they marry in the Church. The "annulment" process is not meant to impose extra hardship on those who avail themselves of it, but rather a way to address the issue that--just as a person married according to the form of religious teaching they were reared within, something must have been lacking since if it were a marriage as Christ intended, the pain and emotional impact of parting would not have been necessary. Anyone who is interested in considering the annulment process should simply call Father. It is NOT horrible, expensive (\$250 is the overall fee, but is immediately waived if requested and no fee is discussed again), or extremely long taking years (average is approximately 4 months). It can bring peace of conscience, closure to past experiences--as well as open up the possibility of marrying within the Church. If it is something that you might at least be more interested in knowing about, just call!
