Members of the Victoria Area Worship Communities are in contact with shelters in Brownsville, McAllen, San Juan, Laredo, and Eagle Pass. Currently these border towns all are receiving 200 to 300 people **daily** seeking asylum and/or refuge as permitted under current U.S. law. While these shelters are funded by various churches, groups and individuals, significant needs remain. They can hardly keep up with basic items to help these people to move on to relatives, families and other shelters throughout our nation. Each shelter has volunteers who are willing to purchase the specific needed items. **Providing Gift Cards (such as HEB, Walmart, VISA, etc.) to these volunteers serves as a very efficient method of helping to meet these immediate needs.**
