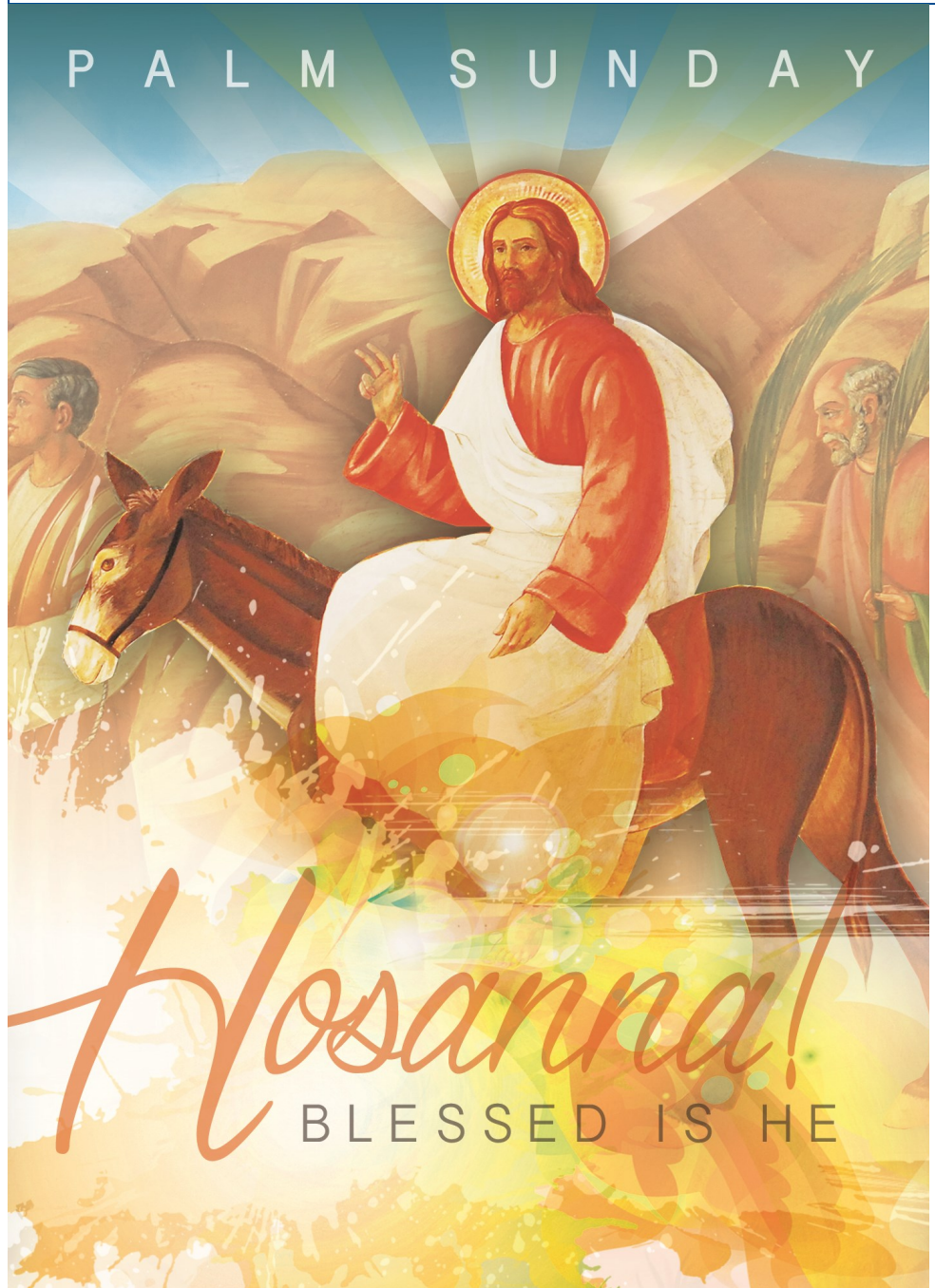

DEAR FRIENDS IN CHRIST,

During Holy Week, let us draw closer to the Lord with prayer and fasting. Remember to keep the fast on Good Friday and abstinence from meat. Catholics aged 14-59 keep the fast by limiting themselves to one main meal. Two little meals are allowed if needed to maintain strength, making sure that the amount of these smaller meals is not greater than the main meal.

Jesus enters into the heavenly sanctuary. Scripture says he goes behind the veil, as the heavenly realities are hidden from our eyes. The Jewish high priest used to enter behind the veil into the Holy of Holies each year to atone for the people's sins with the blood of an animal sacrifice. Jesus Christ entered into heaven, not with the blood of bulls or goats but with his own blood shed for us on the cross. This is an excellent week to read the Letter to the Hebrews in your Bible, which explains the meaning of Christ's offering for sin.

Draw close to Jesus in the Liturgy for Holy Week and Easter. Draw near to Him in prayer and in the reading of Holy Scripture. Easter is only one week away!
