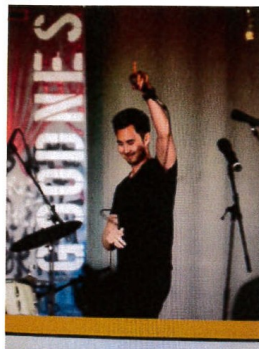

This week's Gospel picks up with the very next verse from last week, with Jesus continuing images of what the Kingdom of Heaven is like. Last week it was weeds and wheat, a mustard weed and leaven in bread. (BTW, do you recall all these parables from my few words? If so, then stop thinking you don't know the Bible! Catholic Christians know the Bible by story memory, not chapter and verse! And that is okay!!)

Both weeks we hear that "the bad and the good" grow and live together. Fish in the sea. Weeds among the wheat. Remember this - God lets both the good and the bad grow.

A fish is bad because of its flesh, not its size. A plant is a weed because it cannot nourish us, not because it is small or large. Today's Gospel tells us that as we live our lives, we will constantly be surrounded by things that will nourish us and things that will poison us.

The Kingdom happens every moment we choose the good, when we choose what will feed us and others. Spiritually and physically.

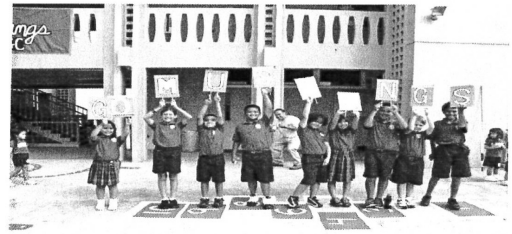
