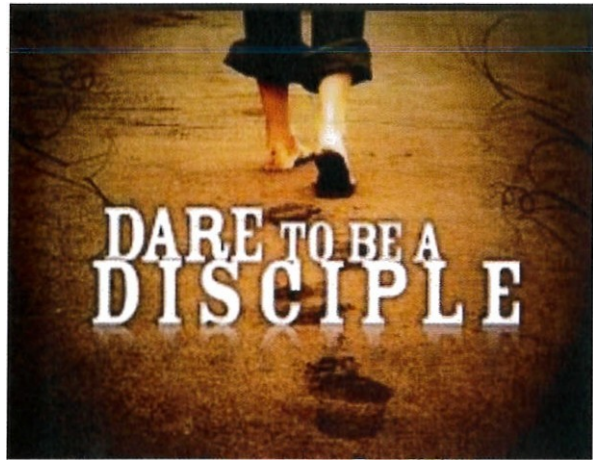
What has always struck me about today's Gospel is how the more Jesus asked them not to talk about him healing the deaf man, the more the people went around telling others. How hard it is to fulfill the one thing Jesus asks!

If there was only one thing that Jesus was asking of you right now, what would it be? You may not have to think hard - it may be the first thing that pops into your head. Or, if you are flooded with ideas,, I would suggest that it is probably not associated with a "should" or a "could" but the one thing is the quiet suggestion standing behind all the distracting noise.

Whatever Jesus asks, I am convinced that it is well within your abilities to fulfill it. But it probably won't be easy.

Jesus has a way to asking that which is not necessarily difficult in the objective sense (aka, "don't tell others what you saw"), but which is nonetheless hard for us at the moment.

Today, will you be the deaf man who begins hearing or the hearing crowd who choose to be deaf?

Pro-Life Reflection

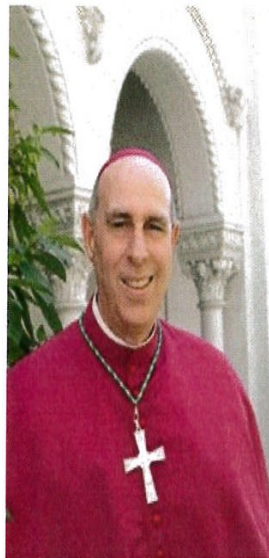
Euthanasia is a serious violation of Divine Law
