## WELCOME BACK TO SCHOOL

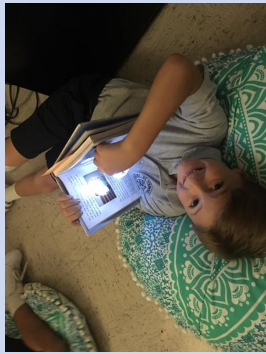
We're here to guide you through an "Un-Bee-lievable" school year!

## UNIFORM REMINDERS:

- **CREW SOCKS** –All white crew socks are worn by ALL students PK3—8<sup>th</sup> Grade. Crew socks must touch the bottom of the calf. Girls must wear knee-high socks with Dress Uniform.
- **2<sup>nd</sup> Grade Boys** must wear a solid black belt daily with shorts and pants.
- **Elementary skirts** must be green plaid that are purchased at Uniform Plus. Girls PK3—5<sup>th</sup> may not wear navy blue skorts or capris. Only navy blue shorts or pants. Girls in Middle School (6<sup>th</sup> -8<sup>th</sup>) must have pleats all the way around skirt.
