

# **HAPS DISTRICT RULES**

## **SOCCER**

(Last Updated August 2018)

National Federation of High School Sports Rules will apply for soccer. Special rules or restrictions will apply as listed below.

1. The game will consist of two 30 minute halves for girls and boys games. Halftime shall be 10 minutes in length.
2. Tie –breakers – Golden goal for 10 minutes; then if tie remains it goes to PKs.
3. A championship game will be played at the higher seed.
4. As a general rule, the girls will play the game first, immediately followed by the boys team.
5. Ties will be decided by head-to-head competition in the season. The next step, if there is not enough time to play a tie-breaker game, a coin toss will be made with a Board member of HAPS officiating the toss. This can be done by conference call if both schools agree.
6. The host school will be responsible for all game costs.
7. If a team chooses to not play the tournament, the next team in the standings will fill that spot. The team choosing to not play will need to meet before the HAPS membership to determine if there will be any consequences for not finishing the season.
8. For the two schools playing in the championship, any trophies and/or awards will be the mutual agreement of the two schools involved.
9. One certified official is required for all district games.
10. Home teams should be in dark colored jerseys. Visiting teams should be in white colored jerseys.
