GUEST SPEAKER: Fr. Brian Gross, Pastor of Church of Epiphany, Watford City, ND,
Diocese of Bismarck, ND

Fr. Brian Gross attended the Pontifical College Josephinum in Columbus, Ohio and was ordained a priest for the Diocese of Bismarck, ND on June 3rd, 2010. He served as associate pastor for Cathedral of the Holy Spirit in Bismarck, ND for two years. In 2012 he was assigned pastor of Epiphany Catholic Church in Watford City, ND and it's mission parish Our Lady of Consolation in Alexander, ND. He presides over a parish that has seen rapid growth over the last seven years from fewer than 100 families to now over 300. In addition to his role as pastor, he is also chaplain for the Diocese of Bismarck's Rachel's Vineyard retreats and assists with deliverance ministry and healing services throughout the diocese. He is currently preparing for a three month sabbatical with Encounter Ministries in the Diocese of Lansing in the fall of 2019.
