- **1.** All Prenuptial papers are to be filed in the archives of the parish church where the wedding takes place.
- **2**. If Dispensation from Canonical Form is granted, the Prenuptial papers are filed in the parish of the Catholic party.
- **3.** A notification of the marriage of Catholics is to be sent to the church of their baptism immediately following the wedding.

Each of the parties should be interviewed alone and under oath. The interviewer should propose the questions and write the answers given. This interrogatory must be kept on permanent file in the parish of marriage. If the following questions should reveal an impediment or anything else that may stand in the way of a valid marriage or a licit marriage, please consult the Chancery.
