Sick Calls – Please call the rectory to arrange for Father Jasany to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized.

Weddings – Parishioners are asked to call the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment with Father Jasany.

Baptisms – The 1st & 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class.

Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism. Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class.

The next class will be on Sunday, March 6th at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish at 11:45 am.

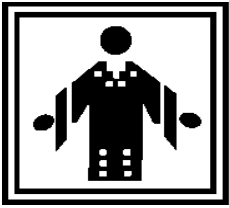
Reservations needed; please call 216-2641-2829 to make your reservation.

Lent calls us to make a journey from Ashes to Easter. The ashes remind us of what we are called to die to. Easter calls us to rise to New Life. We are called to join the Universal Church in going on a forty-day retreat during the Holy Season of Lent.

Part of every traditional retreat is to go to confession and to spend time in quiet before the Blessed Sacrament. Those two wonderful opportunities will be before us this coming week. During this Year of Mercy, we are called to experience Mercy and to extend Mercy. We experience Mercy in the Sacrament of Penance and in Eucharistic Adoration.

Wednesday, February 24th, confessions will be heard in every Catholic Church including ours from 5 to 8 pm. In addition to possibly going to confession yourself, consider inviting someone from your family circle, a relative, a friend, a neighbor to come to the Sacrament of Penance. Invitations are at the entrances of our church. Give an invitation to someone to come to the Sacrament of Penance. Personally hand an invitation out, leave an invitation in someone's mailbox or on someone's dining room table.

Please consider spending some quiet time with our Blessed Lord before the Eucharist on Saturday, February 27th. The Holy Eucharist will be solemnly exposed in the monstrance after the 4 pm Mass. We will have a half-hour of quiet time before Our Lord.

At 5:30 pm, we will have our Solemn closing with Taize Meditation and Benediction.

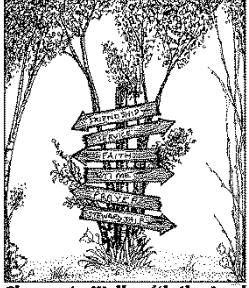
