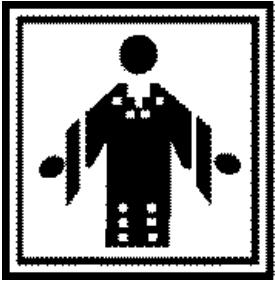
Sick Calls – Please call the rectory to arrange for Father Jasany to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized.

Weddings – Parishioners are asked to call the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment with Father Jasany.

Baptisms – The 1st & 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism. Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class. **The next class will be on Sunday, June 11th at Our Lady of Lourdes Parish at 11:45 am.** Reservations needed; please call 216-641-2829 to register.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate the Descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles and on us. The Blessed Virgin Mary had a special relationship with the Holy Spirit. Through the power of the Holy Spirit, she conceived our Savior and Lord, Jesus Christ.

Periodically, Mary has appeared on the earth to invite us to return to God. Mary appeared six times in Fatima, Portugal; May 13th to October 13th, 1917 to three shepherd children. Briefly stated, she appeared during World War I to give us a peace plan for our world and for our individual lives.

This is a special Jubilee Year, which celebrates the 100th Anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady of Fatima. In celebration of this year, a plenary indulgence of the jubilee will be granted to those who devotedly make a pilgrimage to the Shrine of Fatima in Portugal, Fatima. In addition, the jubilee plenary indulgence may be granted in the following two ways:

1. To the pious faithful who visit with devotion an image of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly displayed for public veneration in the temple, oratory or adequate place, during the day of the anniversary of the apparitions (the 13th of each month from

May to October 2017) and devotedly participate there in any celebration of the Virgin Mary, pray the Our Father, recite the Profession of Faith (Creed) and invoke Our Lady of Fatima.

We will have a special celebration on June 13th with a Mass at 7 pm and a rosary in our church. The Diocesan Pilgrim Virgin Statue of Our Lady of Fatima will be present.

2. To the faithful who due to their age, disease or other serious reason are impeded of moving, if repentant of all their sins and having the firm intention of performing as soon as possible, the three conditions mentioned below, in front of a small image of Our Lady of Fatima, spiritually unite in the days of the apparitions to the Jubilee celebrations, offering with trust to God all merciful through Mary their prayers and pains, or the sacrifices of their own lives.

To obtain the plenary indulgence, the faithful, truly penitent and animated with charity, must ritually fulfill the following conditions – Sacramental confession, Eucharistic communion and Prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.

Invocation of Our Lady of Fatima may be made with the following prayer:
O God, who chose the Mother of your Son to be our Mother also, for the salvation of the world, we may further effectively each day the reign of Christ, who lives and reigns for ever and ever. Amen.

In addition to this special celebration June 13th for the granting of the plenary indulgence (which is further described on the insert in our bulletin), there are other opportunities to celebrate this special year in honor of Our Lady of Fatima.

We have First Saturday Devotions on the First Saturday of the month at 3:15 pm in our church. We also have the Fatima Cell Hour of Holiness at 12:30 pm in our church on the second Sunday of the month.

Finally, we are having a Fatima Centennial Conference July 28th-29th, 2017 at the Embassy Suites Cleveland Rockside. For more information visit www.neofatimaconf.com or call 440-241-5788.

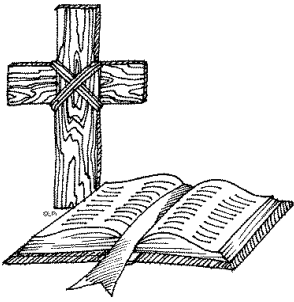

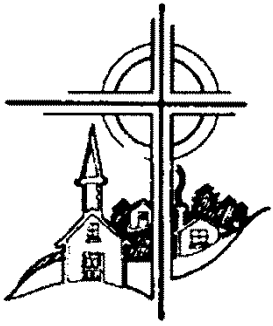
The 50th Wedding Anniversary Celebration
