Sick Calls – Please call the rectory to arrange for Father Jasany to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized.

Weddings – Parishioners are asked to call the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment with Father Jasany.

Baptisms – The 1st & 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class.

Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism. Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class.

The next class will be on Sunday, January 7, 2018 at Holy Name Parish at 1 pm. Reservations needed; please call 216-271-4242 to register.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

Dear Parishioners,

In Mark's Gospel, John the Baptist quotes the prophet Isaiah. "Prepare the way of the Lord, make straight His

paths." I am grateful to those who came to our Communal Penance Service on Monday evening, December 4th. Ideally, before Christmas all of us can go to confession. Confessions are heard on Saturday from 3 to 3:30 pm. You may also call the rectory for an appointment if you wish. Ongoing repentance and conversion is a way to prepare the Way of the Lord in our lives.

Also in preparing the Way of the Lord, we can use the blue Advent books for daily mediation. Please pick up a blue book if you have not yet done so. They are at the entrances of our church.

Advent calls us to quiet prayer. We will have two opportunities for Eucharistic Adoration. Sunday, December 10th at 12:30 pm will be exposition of the Blessed Sacrament, the Rosary, Reflection, Benediction, the Divine Praises, Chaplet of Divine Mercy and the Act of Consecration to Mary; and Saturday, December 16th after our 4 pm Mass we will have quiet prayer. We will expose the Blessed Sacrament at 5 pm. We will have quiet prayer before our Eucharistic Lord from 5 to 5:30 pm. At 5:30 pm we will have Eucharistic Adoration with Taize Meditation and Benediction.

Hopefully, many of you can take advantage of these opportunities to pray before our Eucharistic Lord. Isaiah's call to "Prepare the Way of the Lord!" is the announcement that a herald of a king made to a city in advance of the king's arrival. Roads were in bad shape, if they existed at all. So the way had to be repaired or built so that the king and his company could even get into the city.

How can I build this road for the King? Confession, Personal Prayer, Prayer before the Eucharist are ways to construct the road for Christ to be reborn in our hearts this Christmas.

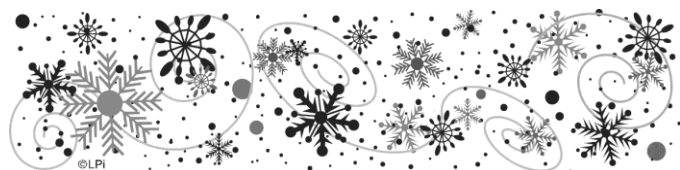

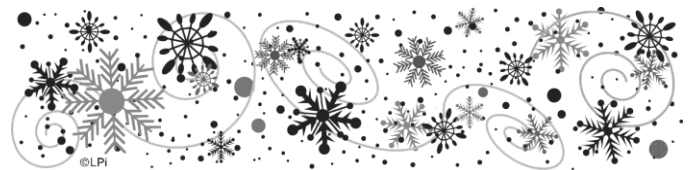

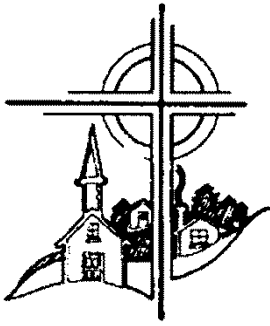
