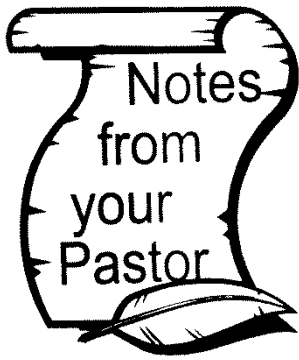
Sick Calls – Please call the rectory to arrange for Father Jasany to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized.

Weddings – Parishioners are asked to call the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment with Father Jasany.

Baptisms – The 1st & 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism. Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class. **The next class will be on Sunday, November 4th at St. John Nepomucene at 12:30 pm.** Reservations needed; please call 216-641-8444 to register.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

Dear Parishioners,

I wish to congratulate everyone who worked on our St. Wenceslaus celebration on September 29th.

It was truly a beautiful and inspirational event in the life of our parish. I thank Pauline and Sue McDonough for the organizational help.

I express my gratitude to all our liturgical ministers. Special thanks to Buck McDaniel and our visiting musicians for the inspirational music at our afternoon concert and liturgy.

I will be away at Sawmill Creek for the Priesthood Convocation from October 9th thru the 12th. Our weekday masses are cancelled.

You probably will notice the scaffolding up in the church. We are having the implementation of an insurance claim for damage done by an ice jam on the East 50th side of the church and storm damage from water that came in from the rose window. The total cost to repair the inside damage to the plaster and paint is \$43,634.00. Insurance will pay for all the repairs and restoration of the inside damage with the exception of our \$1,000.00 deductible.

In addition, the parish will pay to repair and prevent the damage from occurring from the outside again. In reference to the ice jam, the parish will pay \$5,304.00 for heating cables and the electrical tie-in

on the roof on the East 50th side as well as \$800.00 for caulking of the outside of the rose window.

October is a month dedicated to Mary. At Fatima Portugal on October 13, 1917 Our Blessed Mother identified herself as "Our Lady of the Rosary." Everyone is invited to participate in a Mile for Mary which includes a Eucharistic Procession with Rosary in reparation for sins committed against the Immaculate Heart of Mary. The day will begin with an 8 am Mass at St. Charles Parish. Afterwards, there will be a Eucharistic procession with Rosary. We will walk to St. Francis de Sales Church, where we will have Eucharistic Exposition, a talk by Mark Moran, Benediction of the Blessed Sacrament and refreshments. Everyone is warmly invited and encouraged to attend.

We are having a special Alumni Mass on Saturday, October 20th at 4 pm in our church. There will be a social in our hall after the mass. Please see the flyer in this weekend's bulletin and fill out the form. Drop the form in the collection basket or bring it to the rectory office. This is a great way to reconnect with your classmates.
