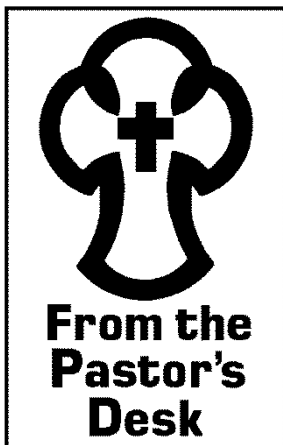

**Godparent and Sponsor Certificate** – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. 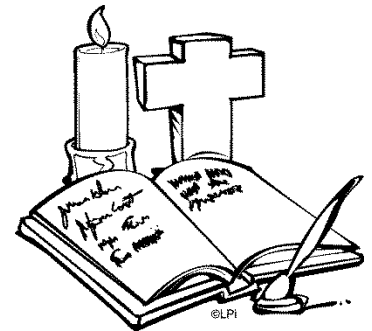
### **All are invited to attend Catholic Renewal Ministries' 37<sup>th</sup> Annual Conference**
