Bishop Perez has authorized an accurate up to date list of clerics who have substantiated allegations of sexual child abuse be posted on the Diocesan Website. Please see the announcement in this week's bulletin. We pray for all the victims, that they may find healing. The Diocese of Cleveland has been handling allegations of sexual abuse in a responsible manner. Clerics are removed from office, put on administrative leave and then an investigation occurs. After the investigation, if allegations are substantiated, further action is taken in regards to the cleric; such as removal from the clerical state or being directed to a life of prayer and penance.

Hopefully, all the steps which the Diocese is taking will help victims with healing and will prevent further abuse in the future.

Again, my thanks to everyone who helped make my 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary a special occasion.

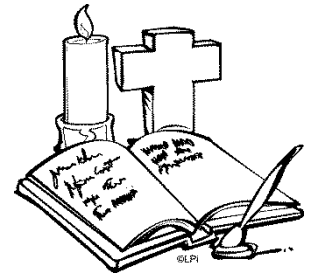

**A Message from the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland...** Since April of 2002 the Catholic Diocese of Cleveland has published on its website the names of those clerics who were removed from ministry from 2002 through the present as a result of the sexual abuse of a child. At Bishop Perez's direction, this information has now been compiled in a list format and updated to include the names of additional diocesan clerics who were removed from ministry as a result of sexual abuse of a child or who is already deceased or no longer in ministry for any reason and against whom have been made substantiated allegations of child sexual abuse.

The new names of diocesan clerics were added after the diocese concluded, based on the evidence available to it, that the allegations were more likely than not to be true. In compiling this updated information, the diocese reviewed all known allegations regardless of how long ago the alleged abuse occurred or whether the cleric was alive or deceased.

While the updating of this information is certainly an occasion of profound sadness, inasmuch as it reminds us of the great harm experienced as a result of sexual abuse, may it also be an occasion for healing and a step towards restoring trust in the Church.
