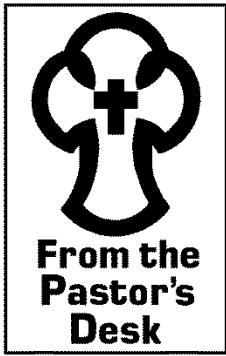
Sick Calls – Please call the rectory to arrange for Father Jasany to bring the Sacraments when a member of your family is hospitalized.

Weddings – Parishioners are asked to call the rectory office at least 6 months in advance of the wedding to schedule an appointment with Father Jasany.

Baptisms – The 1st & 3rd Sunday of the month at 12:00 pm. Parents are required to attend Pre-Baptism Class. Arrangements must be made a minimum of 2 weeks prior to the date of baptism. Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class. **The next class will be on Wednesday, August 7th at St. Stanislaus at 7 pm.** Please call 216-341-9091 to register.

Godparent and Sponsor Certificate – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

Dear Parishioners,

Our good friend and neighbor, Father Joseph Callahan, the Pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes recently suffered a stroke. Let us pray for Father Callahan that he may

make a speedy recovery. To the extent that I am able, I will be of assistance to his parish in the meantime.

Our annual Parish Picnic will be held on Sunday, August 25th at Klima Gardens, 4646 East 71st Street in Cuyahoga Hts. We will gather in prayer to open our picnic by celebrating our 11 am Mass on the picnic grounds. I hope that you plan to attend and invite your family and friends to join us.

Funds from our Parish Picnic will help defray the cost of the concrete and asphalt repairs on the first entrance off East 50th Street to our parking lot. The cost of this project is \$12,489.00. This project is taking place now and hopefully you will see the completed project this weekend.

A quick summary of the job is that the job requires 600 square feet of 6" thick concrete to be removed. We will have 600 square feet at 8" thickness of new concrete installed. The new code states that concrete has to be 8 inches thick. It will be broom finished after installation. They used 6-1/2 MS fast dry cement so that it can be driven on in 48 hours. The asphalt repairs are needed for approximately 110 square feet.

All permits and bonds were included in the cost. The driveway was badly deteriorated and we needed to get the job done now.

Jamie McAlarney, a parishioner and member of our Finance Council was willing to oversee this job. He oversees building and parking lot maintenance for University Hospitals. He was in charge of eleven hospital buildings and parking lots. Kyle Gedeon from Southwest Companies is supervising the subcontractors and the work. We have worked successfully with Kyle and Southwest Company on other projects on our property.

Please remember to pick up your raffle tickets from the radiator at the school side entrance of our church building after Mass. It would be great if everyone could buy or sell their raffle tickets. You may return your tickets by dropping them in the collection basket, mailing them to the rectory, dropping them off at the rectory or turning them in the day of the picnic at the Parish Raffle Booth.

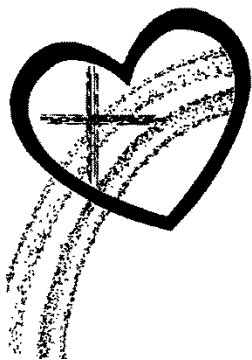
