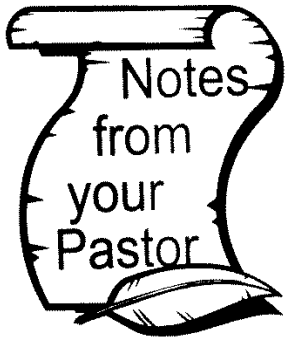

Before parents baptize their child, Diocesan and parish policy requires you to complete a Baptism Preparation Class. **The next class will be on Wednesday, August 7th at St. Stanislaus at 7 pm.** Please call 216-341-9091 to register.

**Godparent and Sponsor Certificate** – Sponsors for Baptism or Confirmation must be registered and practicing members of the Church, attending weekly and Holy Day Masses for a minimum of 3 months prior to the celebration of the Sacraments for which they have requested the certificate. Please note individuals 18 years of age and older, no longer in school, need to register.

A few highlights from that homily:

d) We have a wonderful St. Vincent de Paul Society which helps with these issues. Please call the rectory if you wish to join.

e) We partner with other parishes when there is a crisis in a family or in a person's life. Recent examples – we partnered with St. Martin of Tours, St. Basil and St. Patrick parishes.

 Thanks for your donations of canned goods, non-perishable food items and financial assistance to our parish St. Vincent de Paul Society to help the needy in our midst.
