# Pastor's Paragraphs

Dear Parishioners,

“Thank God and Blessed Mother for all things.” This is the sign by the Blessed Mother statue on Independence Road. We thank Karen Small and Gary Kotlarsic for overseeing the cleaning of our Marian Statue on Independence Road. On the school building by the main entrance we have the sign that states “Thanks be to God and His Dear Mother for all things” 1964 Rev. Clarence A. Liederbach, MA., Pastor. In our parking lot entrance to our former convent, which is now the kindergarten building by the flagpole, we have a Marian Statue that stands atop a marble stand that has an engraving that states, “Dear Mother Keep Us in Thy Grace.” We thank Chester and Mary Cuiksa for their donation of time, labor and materials to re-landscape the area by the flagpole in memory of Delores Cuiksa and in honor of Our Blessed Mother. Chester and his workers will remove the overgrown evergreen bushes, place a cement footer, plant twelve rosebushes and move up the marble stand for the outside Marian Statue.

Upon closer examination, I saw that both hands of the outside Statue of Mary were damaged and that the nose of the figure is deteriorated. It is a simple cement statue of Mary. So I am presently thinking of replacing that cement statue of Mary with another cement statue of Mary.

It appears to me that in our outside Marian statues, our statues, and artwork, and stained glass windows in the church,

in our Marian devotions and in our parishioners lies hidden this invitation to come to Jesus thru Mary.
