The next class will be on Sunday, October 6th at Immaculate Heart Parish at 1:30 pm. Please call



Dear Parishioners,

This weekend we celebrate our Commitment Weekend. Our theme is "We Are Growing in Christ Because of You."

We have been highlighting many positive facts on our parish in our past parish bulletins and in last weekend's homily.

Here are a few –

Forty-nine (49) parishioners share their gift of administration to develop, manage and assist me in fulfilling our Parish Mission at St. John's.

In one year, we celebrate over four hundred (400) Liturgies and Prayer Services.

In one year, our Rosary Makers prepare three thousand (3,000) rosaries, which are distributed to the military, hospital patients and the homebound.

We have a rectory food pantry which serves over six hundred (600) people a year. At Christmas, our Giving Tree provides gifts for one hundred thirty (130) needy children.

As you can see, we are touching and changing lives for the better. Your sacrificial giving makes this possible. An attractive brochure was mailed to your home which highlights our parish ministries and contains a pledge card. We are hoping and praying that everyone fills out his or her pledge card this weekend during our liturgies. We ask one member from each household to fill out a pledge card.

We are Growing in Christ Because of You! Many good things are happening at St. John Nepomucene through your generosity. We ask that everyone makes a financial commitment so that our ministries may continue to flourish and to assist us with the upkeep of our facilities and payroll.

Christ calls each of us to sacrificial giving. Christ gave His Life for us on the Cross. We are called to give our lives to Christ and to one another.

Thank you for your prayerful consideration of this request and I look forward to your participation so that we can continue to Grow in Christ Because of You.
