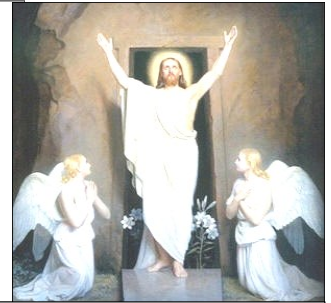

**FATHER'S REFLECTION**

**EASTER TRIDUUM (EASTER TRILOGY OF LOVE)**

'Because of the relationship of person that exists first in God, then between God and us, and finally among us, all things come down to the following three realities: God is love; God loves us; and finally, we must love one another and lay down our lives for each other. If we base our lives on these three realities, they acquire an infinite meaning and whatever vicissitude may arise, we will always be circumscribed by love (Cardinal Jean Danielou).

The trilogy of love is very much shown in our celebration of the Triduum starting Thursday as we begin the Lord's Supper. It started with love given, love received, love enjoyed. On the eve of his death, Jesus did what every human being does on the point of death: he zeroed in on the essential. One could never improve on what he did and said on that tragic evening.

Love is given on Holy Thursday. That's why he instituted once an for all the sacrament of the Eucharist. He has given his body and blood for us to know how to give love. He has shown his priestly responsibility by unifying the human and divine.

Love is received on Good Friday. Suffering becomes his passion and dedication. His passion shows the perfect revelation of God's love to all His children. By his behavior, Jesus manifested his beauty and glory which is only one thing, that is, to love unto death.

Love is enjoyed on Easter Vigil, Holy Saturday. We were promised a savior but we never dreamed that God himself would come to save us. We knew that he loved us, but we never dared to think that he loved us so much as to become like us. That is the way God gives. His gifts are never quite what we expect, but always something better, something far better than we hoped for. We can only dream of things too good to be true. God has a habit of giving things too good to be false.'

Have a meaningful celebration of the EASTER TRIDUUM, indeed a TRILOGY OF LOVE!
