This month we have already jumped back into the Journey's material. This week, March 4-8, we will be focusing on lessons 17 and 18. We are not taking tests on lessons 16-18 due to the Terra Nova testing. In Unit 4 we will focus on the different types of adjectives and verbs, and hone in on persuasive writing. Unit 4 will be completed the last week of March.

In Math we have moved to the second volume and will continue to review previous topics focused on in math, as well as analyzing data, temperature reading, Money, capacity, area, measurement, and division. For extra multiplication support, I have kept the resources on my web page for the students to practice at home. We are constantly working and practicing them in class using the Saxon curriculum and other



supplemental math materials. I continue to strongly recommend working with your student on all facts at home too! Their planners also have a multiplication table for them to reference at home. Flashcards at home are also a great resource for students to use to practice their facts! The students are using Xtra Math in their computers class, and the link can be found on my website to practice at home. Their username and log ins are written in their planners on page 3. Throughout the rest of the year we will work on 3's, 6,8,9, and finally 12.

We are currently focusing on the virtue of Temperance. During March we will explore the season of Lent, Rosary, and The Church.

In Science we have shifted our focus to Physical and Chemical changes!

For Handwriting we have started cursive slowly and are making sure to write correctly and neatly.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter ends March 15<sup>th</sup>. Please be sure to check the students' agendas for the most current schedule for tests, projects and homework assignments. Due to the pace of the classroom changing in the different subjects, dates can change and will be noted in students' planners.
