

The Church's essential dimensions of lifelong faith formation



Liturgical Formation

Formation for “full, conscious and active participation” in our liturgical life – the meaning of the liturgy and the sacraments and the creeds, a spirit of thanksgiving and of repentance, praying with the community of faith.



Knowledge of the Faith

Gradual introduction to the tradition and Scripture, to the full meaning of the creed. Growth in a relationship with Jesus Christ and the community of faith.



Formation for Community Life

Apprenticeship in the ways of the communal life – a spirit of simplicity and humility, care for persons in need and for those who are alienated, communal prayer, correction and forgiveness, love of one another. Knowledge of and love for other Christian communities.



Teaching to Pray

The Lord’s Prayer as the model for all Christian prayer. Develop a spirit of prayer through faith formation and the life of the community. Learn to pray in all circumstances, and to pray with the community of faith.



Moral Formation

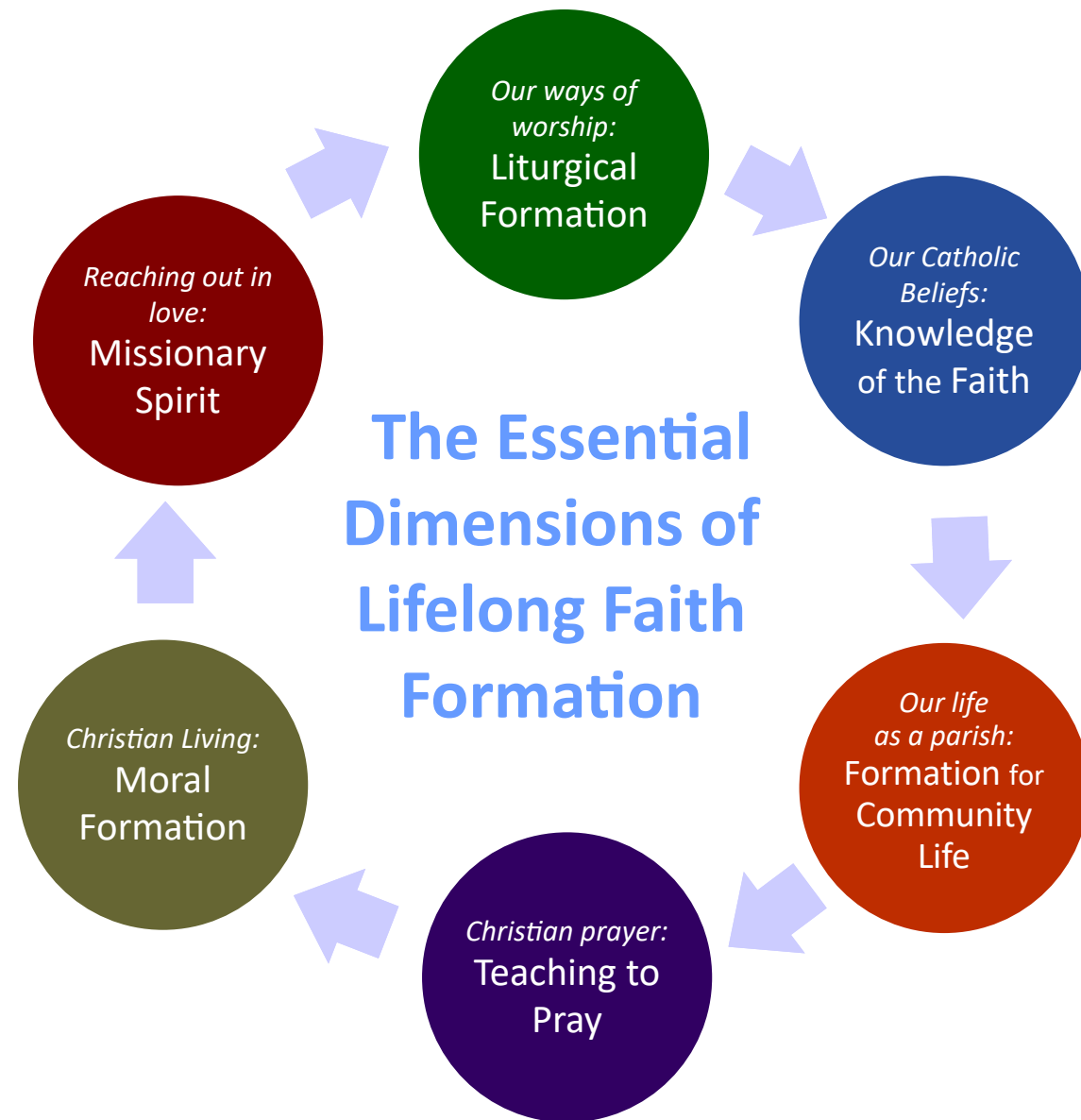
Conversion to Jesus Christ, through a journey of transformation. The Sermon on the Mount as the indispensable basis for moral formation. The challenge to receive the Word of God and put it into practice, including the social consequences of the demands of the Gospel.



Missionary Spirit

Forming disciples for the sake of a mission, present in society as Christians – proclaim Christ by word and deed, promote the common good, work for the transformation of society through social action.
