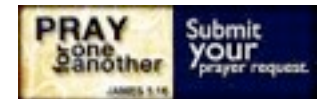

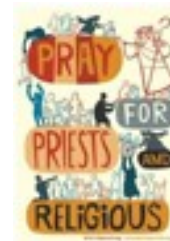

Update on the Diocesan Services Appeal: SSPP goal for March 1, 2018-February 28, 2019 is \$9,042.00. We have a total of 89 registered families of which 45 families have contributed toward our Appeal. The total collected thru October 31, 2018 is \$8,501.38. This includes money sent to the Diocese of Victoria, directly by parishioners and that which has been collected in our weekly collection. We only need \$540.62 to reach our goal. Last year was the first time we had ever completely paid the DSA by parishioner donation i.e. no money was needed from the Church bank accounts to fulfill this obligation. Thank you to all who have been so faithful in giving to the DSA. With help from a few who have not contributed we will make our goal by year's end.

St. Aloysius Diocesan Services Appeal goal is \$6,015.00. To date we have had 2 people donate a total of \$1,700.00 directly to the Diocese of Victoria leaving a balance of \$4,315. We have 35 registered families. If everyone would contribute a little (\$4,315./33 equals \$130.76) we could reach our goal. We realize for some this is too much, but if others would pick up their share and a little more, it will be easy to meet our goal. Please pray about this and donate as the Lord leads.



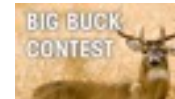

Liturgy of the Word
In today's first reading, we hear Moses reminding us to observe the commandments of our Father, especially to love God first. In the second reading, we see Jesus as the perfect sacrifice who has redeemed us. And in today's Gospel, Jesus adds the second of the two greatest commandments: **to love your neighbor as yourself.**

God's command for us is to love; first to love God with all our heart, soul, mind and strength, and then to love our neighbors as ourselves. Jesus calls these the two greatest commandments. These are not easy commands. They require that we put God and others above our own wants and desires.

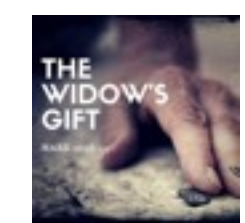
