Abstinence: Age 14+ abstain from meat on Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Evangelization: That Christian communities, especially those who are persecuted, feel that they are close to Christ and have their rights respected.

Liturgy of the Word

In the first reading from Exodus, God speaks to Moses from the burning bush, announcing His presence as the God of his father Abraham, Isaac and Jacob. In St. Paul's letter to the Corinthians, he speaks of the Old Testament ancestors, many with whom God was not pleased. In today's Gospel, the crowd tells Jesus about the Galileans whose blood Pilate mingled with their sacrifices. Jesus calls them to repentance and tells them a parable of the fig tree that produces no fruit.

God's ways are not our ways. In order to bear good fruit, we must allow Him to shape and mold our lives. This was not a new message that Jesus shared, but an affirmation of the covenant that God made with His people from the beginning. God is faithful - and so we are called to be. When we stray and wither or produce bad fruit, we have the opportunity to repent and try again.
