



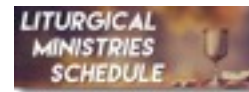

Fasting: Ages 18-59 fast Good Friday, limiting yourself to one full meal and two smaller meals (not to equal one full meal) each day with no snacking in between.

Abstinence: Age 14+ abstain from meat on Good Friday and all the Fridays of Lent.

Liturgy of the Word

In the first reading, God stops the miraculous manna as soon as the Israelites are able to eat the produce of the Promised Land. Paul tells the Corinthians they are a new creation through reconciliation with God. The prodigal son demonstrates God's willingness to welcome us back as soon as we turn to Him.

Jesus' famous parable of the prodigal son depicts God as a father always ready to take back those who stray from Him. No matter how we may have turned away from God, we have only to turn back to Him through the sacrament of reconciliation. Lent is the perfect time to be reconciled to God and to be a new creation for Easter.

Laetare Sunday is the fourth Sunday in the season of Lent, in the Western Christian liturgical calendar. Traditionally, this Sunday has been a day of celebration, within the austere period of Lent. ... "Laetare Jerusalem" ("Rejoice, O Jerusalem") is Latin from Isaiah 66:10. Priests are given the option to wear rose-colored vestments at Mass held on this day in place of the violet vestments normally worn during Lent. The term "rose" is used to describe this lighter shade of the color violet in the Roman Rite.
